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POLLEN AM, 3D PRINTED SURF FINS

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The project was born between sky and sea, in the extreme south of Corsica. After two years of research on a process allowing to overcome the limitations of 3D printing, the team arrived at a new solution: resins, wood, carbon and metal composites, silicones and thermoplastics, the materials can be mixed to produce the objects.

They therefore decided to develop many objects, including surfboards, starting with single fins, to prove that old school and technology can go perfectly together.



Today, it is possible to obtain wooden, carbon or resin fins, all with more or less flexibility depending on the areas chosen.

By giving the possibility of manufacturing not a type of fin for this or that surf but an infinity of sizes, shapes and materials to adapt to all types of waves, Pollen AM can interest shapers, surfers and surf shops...
